

## **Appendix II – Covid-19 additional information**

Whenever England is at a Covid-19 3, 4 or 5 level of alert and schools are open to pupils, this appendix will come into operation.

### **Reflection**

Reflection will be carried out in an unused classroom next to another unused classroom. Children will be socially distanced so that none of them are within 1 m of each other. They will be brought to the room by a member of staff in their bubble, they will not see other children in the corridor as their lunchtime will be staggered.

One in the reflection room they will complete the necessary tasks in the normal way.

### **Unsafe behaviour**

Any pupils not observing the necessary rules regarding:

1. Not getting too close to other children or adults;
2. Entering the classroom or playspace of another bubble;
3. Walking safely and sensibly in the corridors;
4. Using the toilets safely and hygienically

will be given a name or ticks added.

Where pupils are clearly trying to deliberately undermine the confidence of other adults or staff such as running into other bubbles, spitting or coughing near people or not observing the necessary social distancing, they will be given an immediate fixed term exclusion of between 0.5 and 5 days depending on the severity of the incident. This can also be applied retrospectively if required.

### **Uniform**

Pupils are still expected to wear uniform. This should be washed as often as possible and fully cleaned every Wednesday by all families. If parents or carers are having difficulties with this they should contact the Headteacher. Normal sanctions will be applied if this has not happened.
